MOBILE SCREENING CAMP

LRBT avers Free Eye Camp h: Breaking down barriers to eye health in South Asia avers and The Department for International Develop

Mobile eye screening camps provide free eye checks and raise awareness of eye health, hygiene and care.

Medication and minor surgical treatment is provided for patients by the screening service but further investigation and surgery is referred to our hospitals.

The mobile screening programme enables us to reach remote rural communities and socially and economically deprived urban areas with little access to good quality health care.

SPONSORSHIP PACKAGE



Eye screening for 500 patients and 60 minor surgical procedures Cost: Rs 277,750 (£1,700 approx)

- · Surgical costs & medical team salaries
- Transport for Layton Rahmatulla Benevolent Trust (LRBT) medical team and equipment
- Operating space for LRBT medical team
- Power supply (including back up generators)
- Registration and management team
- Waiting room for male and female outpatients and washroom facilities
- · Boarding/lodging facilities for LRBT medical team
- Transport for surgical patients at agreed date/time
- Security arrangements
- Publicity for screening camp

Please note that only preliminary eye screening and minor treatments will take place at the camp. Those in need of detailed examination or surgery will be referred to our nearest hospital.

Arrangements can be made to screen larger numbers of patients.

SADIA'S EYE CAMP

Sadia Warsi travelled to Pakistan after surpassing her target of raising £2,300 to run an eyecamp in Gujar Khan, Rawalpindi. Sadia was joined by Dr Sofia Usman, an Ophthalmologist from Kings College London. Facilities included free provision of:

- * Eye examinations
- * Medicine
- * Refraction and prescription of glasses

300 patients were seen in just two days with 100 prescription glasses offered, 35 cataract surgery referrals, and 9 other ophthalmic surgeries took place at LRBT Mandra Hospital.

ANSAR'S EYE CAMP



Ansar Rafiq successfully raised £3,000+ to fund two eye screening camps in rural areas close to home in Pakistan.

Ansar flew from London to Islamabad, and then travelled with our medical team to undertake a camp in Khari Sharif, a rural area of Kashmir, followed by a second camp in Chak Mew in Jhelum, Punjab.

Eye screening camps protect, promote, and maintain health and prevent disease and disability. In this instance, over 300 patients were seen in total for both camps, with 32 operations completed.

Thanks to Ansar, essential care was able to reach rural areas with little access to high quality eye care.


